BUURHOLT, is scheduled to be delivered during Q1 2023. The second order recently received from Europe's largest milling group, GOODMILLS GROUP, is planned to be delivered during Q2 2023.

The equipment aims towards grain industrial companies with a sustainability agenda, willing to further optimize their grain supply while enhancing quality of their products. This includes grain producers (e.g. large cooperative, grain elevators) as well as processors such as flour mills and malt producers.

The revolutionary modular approach of BoMill InSight™ offers maximum flexibility for operations and easy upgradability. Its smart frame design and compact footprint allow easy

and rapid installation in new or existing grain processing lines. And with its economic installation, operation, maintenance and upgradability, BoMill InSightTM is also cost-efficient, allowing fast return on investment to customers.
